



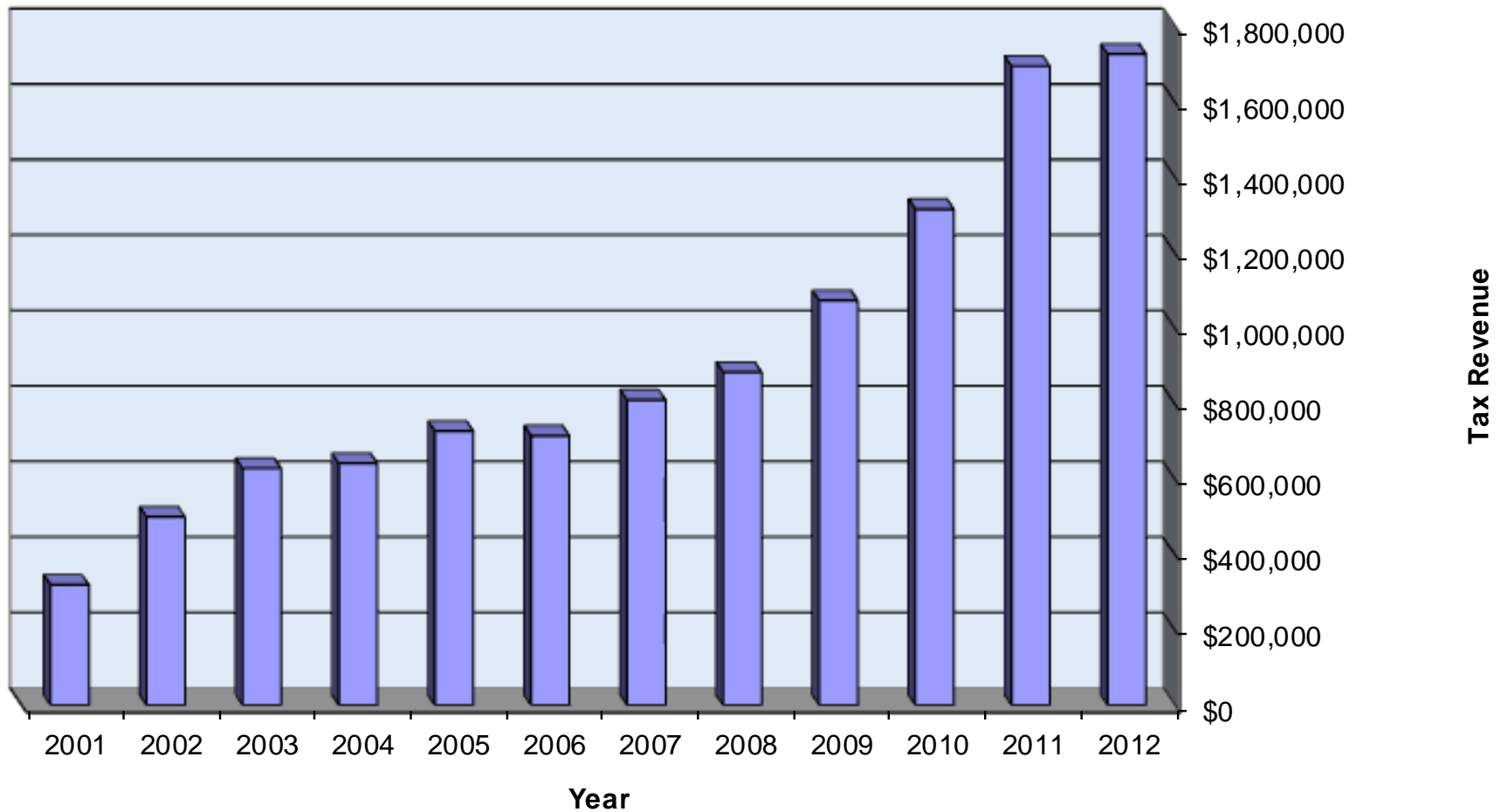

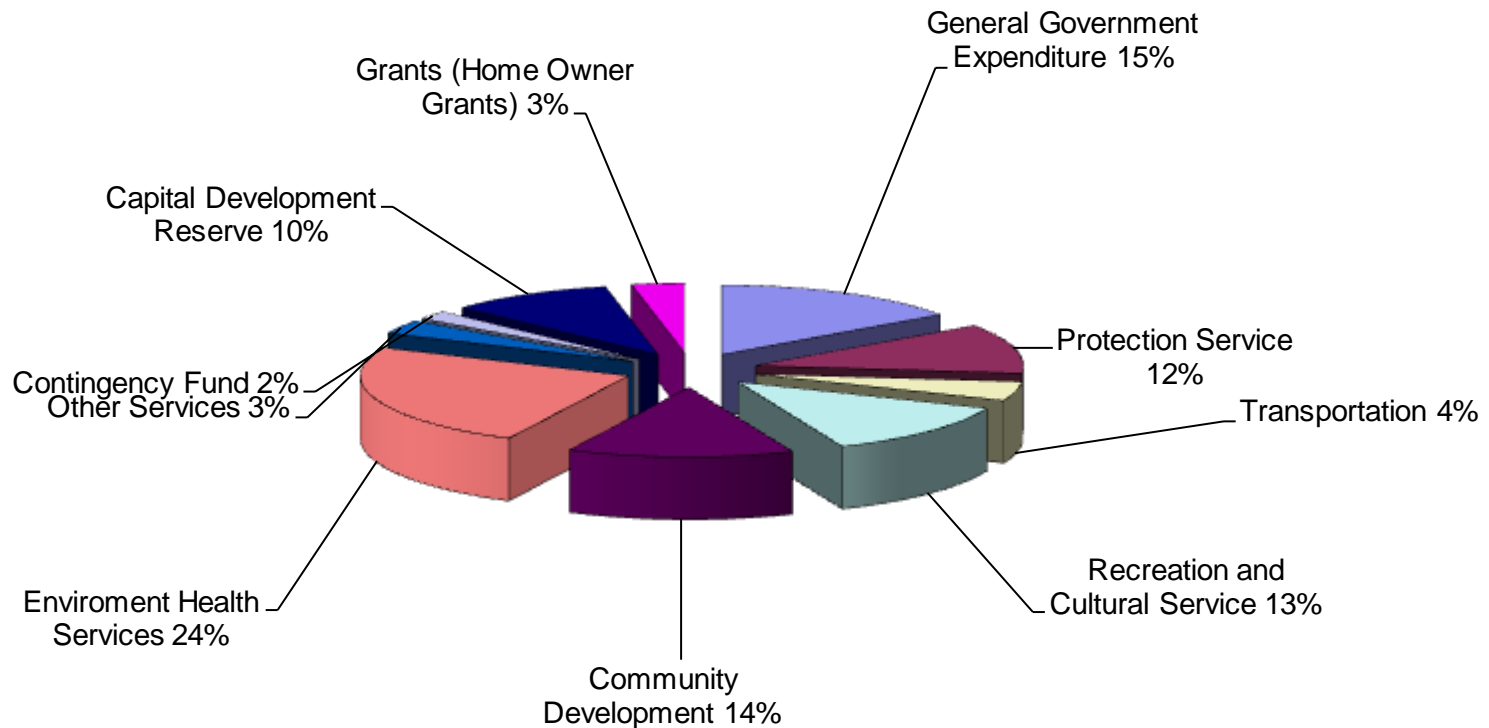
Osoyoos Indian Band Benefits from Taxation Revenue

Benefits of Taxation



- Tax Dollars may be used to leverage financial needs:
 - Use as collateral for financing loans
 - Use for debt service payments to the First Nation Finance Authority (FNFA)
 - Build Capital Reserve Funds to finance capital replacement, renovation and/or development
 - Develop Community initiatives
 - Service other development on Reserve
